(Refuse)

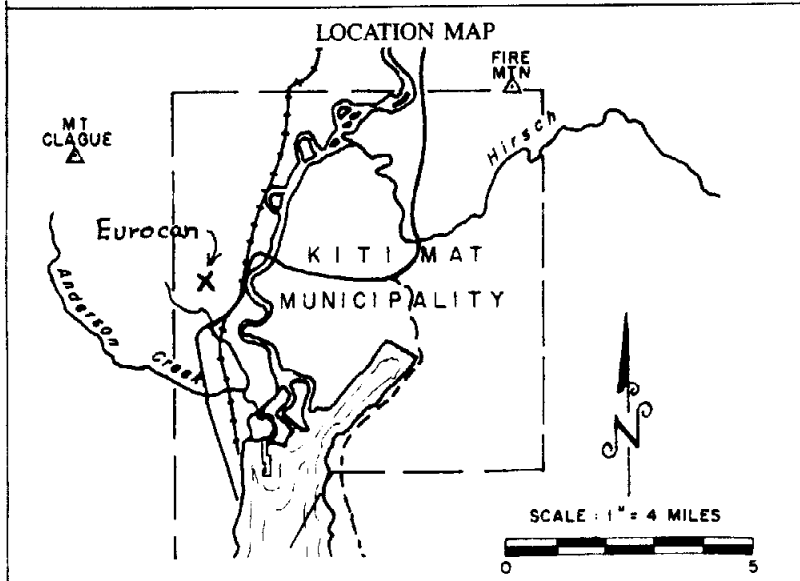
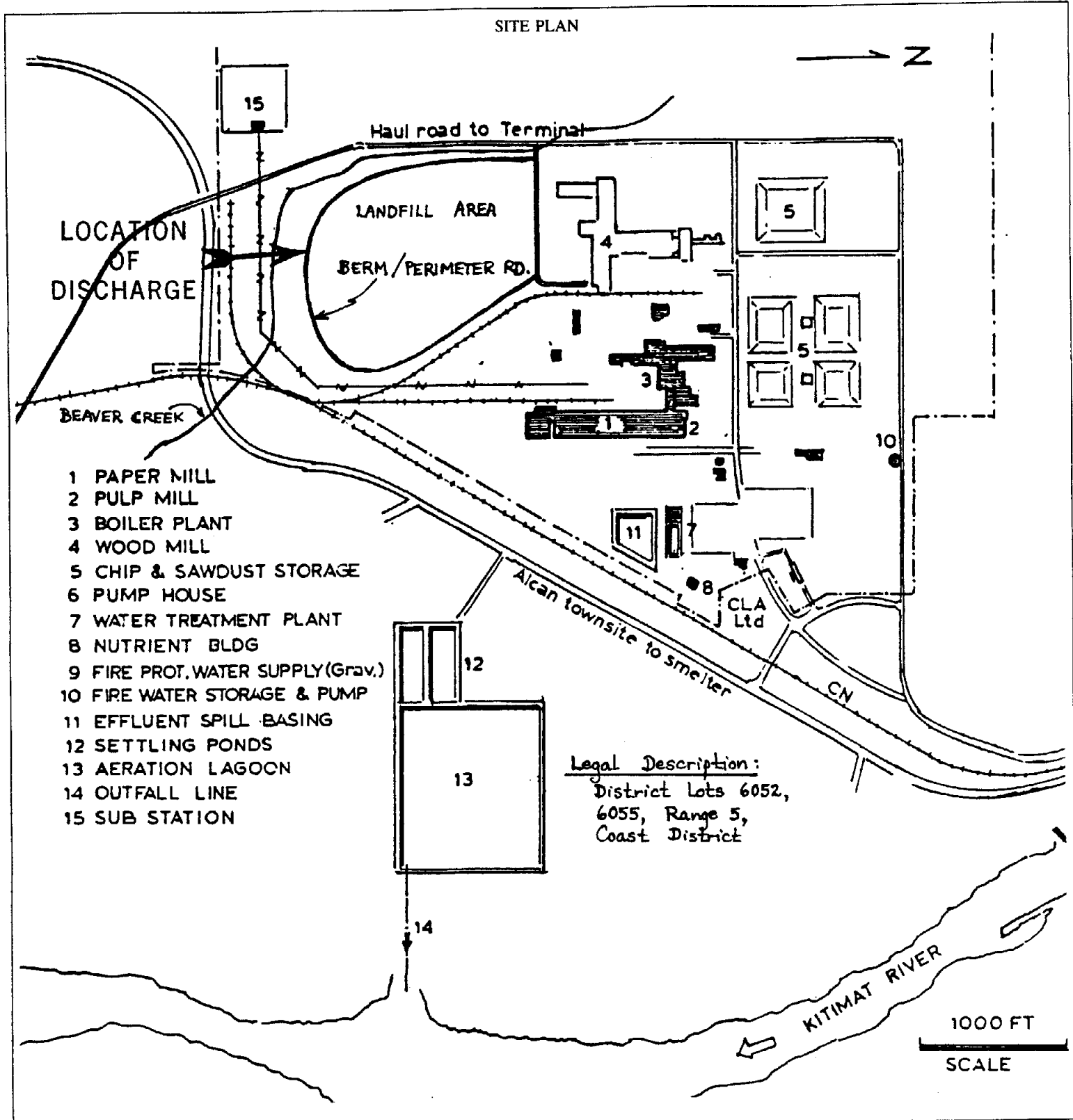
- (a) The discharge of refuse to which this appendix is applicable is from a pulp and paper mill as shown on the attached Appendix A-1.
- (b) The rate at which refuse may be discharged is a maximum of 97 m³ per day.
- (c) The type of refuse which may be discharged is industrial and municipal.
- (d) The components of the refuse which may be discharged are settling pond solids, green liquor dregs, slaker dregs, power boiler ash, miscellaneous inert industrial wastes such as wood, paper and concrete and typical municipal waste.
- (e) The works authorized are a landfill operation as directed in the attached Appendix B-1 and approximately located as shown on the attached Appendix A-1.
- (f) The land to which the refuse is to be discharged and to which this appendix is appurtenant is District Lots 6052, 6055, Range 5, Coast District, as shown on the attached Appendix A-1.
- (g) The works authorized must be complete and in operation on and from the date of this appendix.

APPENDIX No. B-1

to Permit No. PR-1650

1. LANDFILL OPERATION

The Permittee shall maintain the landfill authorized in Appendix 01 as a Level "B" operation in accordance with the Pollution Control Objectives for the Forest Products Industry in British Columbia, dated November 23, 1977, which, in normal conditions, requires that cover material be applied once per 20 days of operation and at least once per month. The Regional Waste Manager may vary the frequency of covering when freezing conditions adversely affect normal operation.

The Permittee shall restrict the disposal of municipal waste to a designated area which is acceptable to the Regional Waste Manager and set back at least 80 metres from the perimeter of the landfill area.

2. SITE PREPARATION AND RESTORATION

Provision of surface water diversionary works, firebreaks and site restoration as required, shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Regional Waste Manager.

3. WILDLIFE NUISANCE

The subject discharge is one that is of concern because of the possibility of a nuisance or hazard being caused by bears or other animals attracted to the site. Additional works may be required or other operating instructions may be issued by the Regional Waste Manager if such problems arise.

APPENDIX No. C-1

to Permit No. PR-1650

1. **RECEIVING ENVIRONMENT MONITORING PROGRAM**

The Permittee shall undertake studies to determine the effect of the leachate from the chip piles and industrial landfill on Symes Creek and Beaver Creek. This program will be undertaken subject to consultation and approval by the Waste Management Branch.

The present monitoring program, which is already underway, shall be maintained until further direction is provided by the Regional Waste Manager. The monitoring program may be modified by the Regional Waste Manager in the future depending upon the monitoring results.

The specific elements of the leachate studies and the monitoring program will be detailed in a separate letter from the Waste Management Branch.
